

Kent Street Detour - July 1-3, 2024

Pavement marking on Kent Street on the Virginia Tech Campus will cause some BT routes to detour, beginning Monday, July 1, 2024 through Wednesday July 3, 2024, from Start of Service through 12:00pm daily. BT will plan to resume normal scheduled routing as soon as possible after Kent Street reopens.

These are planned Road Closures and may be shortened or extended, depending on construction progress and weather.

While on Detour, there are no "courtesy stops." Regular BT stops will serviced. Squires is CLOSED to BT buses.

Bus Stops Affected

All stops on Kent Street will be closed. All stops in Oak Lane will be closed.

Routes Affected

- Hokie Express HXP (70) ***Time Check at Smithfield Lot***
 - From Transit Center Maroon Bay 4, follow normal route to Drillfield, U-TURN to service Newman Library, RIGHT on Alumni Mall, RIGHT on Main Street (***No Right on Red***), RIGHT on Washington Street to resume normal route to Smith field Lot.
 - From Smithfield Lot, LEFT on Duck Pond, LEFT on Smithfield and follow normal route to Washington Street, LEFT on Main Street, LEFT on Alumni Mall, LEFT on Drillfield and U-TURN to resume normal route at Newman Library.
- Campus Shuttle CAS (75,77)
 - From Transit Center Maroon Bay 5, follow normal route to Drillfield, U-TURN to service Newman Library, RIGHT on Alumni Mall, RIGHT on Main Street (***No Right on Red***), RIGHT on Washington Street to resume normal route.
 - From Transit Center Orange Bay 12, follow normal route to Washington Street, LEFT on Main Street, LEFT on Alumni Mall, LEFT on Drillfield and U-TURN to resume normal route at Newman Library.

Notes:

- **This detour is subject to change at any time, so please check often for updates.**
- All affected routes should display PR Code 10 "Detour in Effect" or use the appropriate 5000 Detour destination code.
- Press the "DONE" button when mentor displays OFF ROUTE.
- All affected routes will service all BT stops they pass while on detour. ***While on Detour, there are no "courtesy stops." Regular BT stops will serviced.***
- Rider Alert Signage will posted on all affected stops on Sunday evening.
- Detour details will be posted on the BT Website.
