April 12, 2025 Memorial Run Detours

Run Event is expected to start at 9:00am on Drillfield near War Memorial Hall.

On Saturday, April 12, 2025, Run in Remembrance events taking place on campus will cause BT to detour or delay several routes. Affected routes will resume cross-campus operation at the conclusion of the event, approximately between 11:45am and 12:45pm. CRC Shuttle route will remain on a secondary detour during the VT Spring Game. Schedule delays should be expected.

Bus Stops Affected

<u>All</u> stops around the Drillfield, all stops on West Campus Drive, all stops on Duck Pond from Washington to Oak Lane, all stops on Stanger, all stops on Beamer Way and in South Stadium/Chicken Hill area, and all stops on Washington Street <u>will not</u> be serviced during the run detour. Beamer Way/South Stadium/Chicken Hill stops will remain closed through approximately 7pm, or at the conclusion of Spring Game events.

Routes Affected During Memorial Run on Campus

- Hokie Express (HXP) (70)
 - From Oak Lane, follow normal route to LEFT on Duck Pond, LEFT on West Campus, RIGHT on Prices Fork, RIGHT on Stanger to Maroon Bay 5.
 - From Maroon Bay 5, LEFT on Stanger, LEFT on Prices Fork, LEFT on West Campus, RIGHT on Duck Pond, RIGHT on Oak Lane to resume normal route to Oak Lane.
- Campus Shuttle (CAS) (75,77) [Hold at Transit Center until conclusion of run (Approximately 12:00pm)]
 - From Orange Loop Bay 14, follow normal route.
 - o From Maroon Loop Bay 4, follow normal route.
- CRC Shuttle (CRC) (80)
 - During Run in Remembrance
 - Orange Loop Bay 16 to Research Center Drive (Knollwood)
 - RIGHT on West Campus, LEFT on Prices Fork to RIGHT exit onto 460 East By-Pass, RIGHT Exit onto Southgate to resume normal route to Knollwood Time Check.
 - Research Center Drive (Knollwood) to Orange Loop Bay 16
 - Normal route to Research Center and LEFT at Traffic Circle onto Southgate, RIGHT onto 460 West By-Pass, RIGHT on Prices Fork, RIGHT on West Campus, LEFT into Orange Loop Bay 16.
 - DURING SPRING GAME (NO SERVICE ON BEAMER WAY OR CHICKEN HILL Spring Game.)
 - Orange Loop Bay 16 to Research Center Drive (Knollwood)

- Normal Route to Duck Pond, RIGHT on Southgate to resume normal route.
- Research Center Drive (Knollwood) to Burruss Hall
 - Follow Normal route to Southgate, LEFT at traffic circle onto Duck Pond, to resume normal route.
- AFTER SPRING GAME (BEAMER WAY Open.) Resume Normal Route.
- Buses will begin returning to normal on campus time checks and routes after Alumni Mall and the Drillfield reopens. Estimated around 12:00pm.
